


Mental Health Awareness Month

White House and USICH Launch All INside Initiative to Tackle Unsheltered Homelessness

On May 15, the White House and the U.S. Interagency Council on Homelessness (USICH) launched <u>ALL INside</u>, a first-of-its-kind initiative to address unsheltered homelessness nationwide. ALL INside is a key part of <u>All In: The Federal Strategic Plan to Prevent and End</u> <u>Homelessness</u>, which set a bold goal to reduce homelessness by 25% by 2025 and ultimately build a country where every person has a safe and affordable home.

SAMHSA: Olmstead v. L.C. Resources

In the 1999 Olmstead v. L.C. Supreme Court Decision, the Court found that states are required to provide community-based services that enable individuals with disabilities, including those with serious mental illness (SMI) and serious emotional disturbance (SED), to live in the most integrated setting appropriate to them. SAMHSA has compiled <u>this list of resources</u> to assist states and other stakeholders in planning and implementing systems of care that support community inclusion.
