### SAMHSA Program to Advance Recovery Knowledge (SPARK): Housing Supports Recovery and Well-Being: Definitions and Shared Values

This <u>fact sheet</u> summarizes the role that housing plays in supporting recovery. It describes two common models, recovery housing and supportive housing, emphasizing the importance of promoting choice and ensuring equitable access to different models.
