## Homebase: Managing Uncertainty for CoCs and Homeless Services Providers

This <u>report</u> provides steps for how Continuums of Care (CoCs) and homeless response system providers can manage uncertainty. It covers processing new information as an organization, communicating with service participants following trauma-informed principles, managing CoC grants, and adapting budgets.

## NAEH: Why Criminalization Doesn't Work: Research and Policy Insights

This <u>series of briefs</u> from the Alliance's Homelessness Research Institute summarizes the conclusions of nearly 100 studies on the topic, showing that laws criminalizing

homelessness worsen the crisis by creating barriers to housing and services and causing lasting harm to the people they target.

## TAC: Overdose Prevention in Supportive Housing: A Layered Approach to Savings Lives

This <u>blog post</u> offers layered strategies for preventing opioid overdose in supportive housing settings. It emphasizes a holistic model that focuses on resident well-being and long-term recovery, encompasses technology, harm reduction tools, community response, and evidence-based interventions, and is created with the full involvement and input of tenants and others who use drugs routinely or who have a history of routine drug use.
