Advance Care Planning with People Experiencing Homelessness

As communities pause to honor those who've died on this year's National Homeless Persons' Memorial Day, we are reminded that providers in all kinds of roles can play a role in ensuring people

experiencing homelessness have a chance to express their values and preferences for healthcare. Released earlier this year, HHRC's online course <u>Advance Care Planning</u> <u>with People Experiencing Homelessness</u> introduces learners to advance care planning and provides a framework for communicating with individuals about the options available to them.
